Tyndall implements HPCON Charlie

TYNDALL AIR FORCE BASE, Fla. – Due to an increase in COVID-19 cases on base and in the local community, Tyndall Air Force Base will increase its Health Protection Condition (HPCON) from Bravo Plus to Charlie today, Aug. 2, 2021. Base officials will continue to adjust protective guidelines consistent with recommendations from medical experts as conditions change. HPCON Charlie measures include the following actions:

- Continue essential missions with required manning
- Limit access to installation to official business

Health protection measures such as wearing masks in indoor settings and practicing appropriate social distancing remain in place.
