The number of cases of COVID-19 and the percent testing positive in our local area and state are increasing. We have directed the transition back to Health Protection Condition (HPCON) Charlie and Phase 1 as a result of this increase. The base will transition back to maximizing telework where possible, and you can expect adjustments to the operating procedures at some of our base facilities as a result of this action.
